History - First stop Swedish Kingdom and Arn – The Knight Templar – film and literature tourism

West Sweden played an important part in the birth of the nation of Sweden. Remains from the 12th and 13th centuries, mainly churches and monasteries in scenic surroundings, still bear witness of this period in history. At the turn of the year a Swedish film will open at screens all over Europe: Arn the Knight Templar. It tells the story of crusaders and adventures in the Holy Land but above all it tells the story of the country in the north, West Sweden, which is where the film mainly was shot.
